## Ministerial changes:

On 20<sup>th</sup> June, an email was circulated regarding some changes in ministry at Dorcan Church, especially in the short term. Details are attached to these notices in case you missed it, and if you received these notices in hard print, then copies of the document can be found in both centres. Thank you.

## The Filling Station:

We have been asked if we can help every 3-4months with providing food (mainly prepared sandwiches) to the Filling Station.

They offer clients a total of 120 rounds of sandwiches, wrapped separately and individually labelled (Tuna mayo, ham, cheese and pickle, egg mayo are some favourites); a chocolate bar; and fresh fruit (particularly banana and satsumas)

Supporting churches also supply an additional 4 loaves of sliced bread (used for hotdogs) and 3 litres of milk (for hot drinks).

Is this something that you feel a prompt to support and are willing to get a team together?

If so, or if you would like additional information, please contact Maggie at the office in the first instance and she will put you in direct touch with the coordinator.

In due course it would need to go to ECC for any financial support, so a brief costing would be helpful, however, initially if you feel this is something on your heart then please do find out more!

## **Annual Gift Day.**

This year, even though we are focusing on raising money for St Paul's roof (the total now stands at more than £18,500, praise God, and thank you for your generosity), ECC have decided that it would still be good if we continue to have an Annual Gift Day, but with the money raised being split 50:50 between St Paul's roof and the ongoing ministry and outreach of the Church.

The date set for the Gift Day is Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> July at both St Paul's and St Tim's.

The purpose of this is not to press those of you who have already given generously to the Church this year to give yet more, but rather to provide another opportunity for anyone who has not yet given to do so, and also for all of us to reflect on how we give to the wider work of the church as well as to the roof appeal.

#### **One-off gifts**

If you feel you would like to donate, no matter how large or small, then this can be done in a number of ways:

Special Gift Day Donation Envelopes will be available at both centres from Sunday 7th Juy.
