Sharing of creative ideas seen over the summer

At our AGM you may remember that we shared about a "Focus group", a new working group accountable to the ECC. This group is tasked with focusing and leading our work on shaping a future strategy and direction for Dorcan church following Building God's House. It is a place where creative ideas can be shared and received, where the discernment process is overseen (which will engage the whole church) and from where priorities are recommended to ECC.

We have recently had our first meeting and began to think about how we might embark on our vision post Building God's House. To get us started as a church, one idea was looking at what other churches do and why. Over the summer more of us tend to visit other churches whilst we are away and we would be grateful if you could share good ideas that you pick up from churches you visit – in particular how they serve their particular unique community - what kind of mission and mission do they focus on and, if you get into conversation, what has worked and what have they learned from things which haven't been so successful. Could what you learn from your visits trigger some ideas for us at Dorcan? Please do share what you pick up with the Focus group – it will be very helpful indeed.

As a church we are at the very early stages of discerning a vision and our priorities. Over the coming months and into 2023 we will be exploring this further, engaging all of us as a church. In the meantime, as we start this journey, please start thinking and praying about our mission and ministry in this community, and our centres at St Timothy's and St Paul's.
