## Trudie's return - update

Thank you for the lovely welcome back last Sunday – it was good to see you and I missed the church family greatly. I have appreciated the contact and prayers from many of you, and all the wonderful cards, gifts, flowers and surprises that have kept me feeling held. And a massive thank you goes to all the wonderful people who have covered for me whilst I have been away – thank you so very much to a great team.

I am starting back in a limited capacity and on a part-time basis. During October, I will be focusing predominantly on Sunday services and associated preparation, and later in the month will be attending the Bristol Diocesan clergy 3-day conference, as expected of incumbents. I am still required to commit to significant physio which I am truly hoping and praying will avoid a further procedure, and if all goes to plan I will be increasing my hours from November and hope to be full time in December - ready for Christmas! This approach is at the direction of the Diocese and Archdeacon team, and I also have the support of an assigned person locally to help me adjust. This does mean that I will need to prioritise what I commit to, and I'm sure there will be some challenging decisions to be made, so thank you for your understanding. Of note, is that one piece of work I need to address as a priority is starting the paperwork and processes for employing a safeguarding co-ordinator which I will look to focus on in November. However, the legal paperwork associated with our change in ecumenical constitution (which we are signing on 24<sup>th</sup> November), will now need to wait until the new year. In the meantime. I really am hoping that we will be able to find someone in the wider deanery to help us with this.

It really was great to see so many of you last week, and thank you for your ongoing prayers and understanding. With my love and prayers to you, as always.
