New Electoral Roll

Every six years we are required to draw up a completely new electoral roll and 2025 is such a year – lucky us! The formal legal letter is now displayed in both centres, and over the next few weeks we will be looking to rebuild our roll, ready for the annual meeting in the Spring.

As in previous years, the electoral roll form is used for inclusion on the Membership of both Dorcan Church Swindon (the Single Congregation Local Ecumenical Partnership), as well as the electoral roll of the Anglican Parish of Dorcan. Whilst we are currently in the process of moving from our Single Congregation Local Ecumenical Partnership to a new Ecumenical Co-operative Scheme with Church of England as the lead partner, the electoral roll form is fit for both purposes during the transition.

Very soon forms will be available for you, and most will be named personally. If there isn't one for you, then we are sorry. It is likely to be due to data protection guidelines, or that we don't have your details, or that we've just got it wrong! If so, please do forgive us, and then pick up an unaddressed application form and fill it in. In both centres, on Sunday 23rd February, there will be the opportunity to complete the forms prior to the services, and then again at the united service at St Paul's on 2nd March. But don't worry if you miss this, the forms can be picked up, completed and returned at a later date.

Being on the electoral roll is a significant way of showing your membership and home amongst the church family here at The Dorcan Church. So please do consider joining the roll once more, or perhaps for the first time. Additionally, entry on the roll means that you can vote for the officers of the Dorcan Church, stand for Church Council, exercise other roles which require being on the electoral roll, and also speak at the Annual Meeting. We do hope that you will welcome this opportunity to join the membership with your brothers and sisters here at Dorcan Church.
